Session IV: Strategic Decisions and Next Steps to Deliver the Summit

This document presents the latest version of the draft programme of the 2022 Effective Development Co-operation Summit. The session structure is updated based on discussions with different stakeholders. Most session leads have been confirmed at the time of publishing and have started the substantive preparations of the individual sessions. Spotlight sessions have all been confirmed by Co-chairs based on the expressions of interest received.

An updated version will be published with the revised 'Road to the Summit'.

This programme should be read alongside a proposed operational roadmap for Steering Committee members included at the end of the document. This operational roadmap indicates actions for the Steering Committee to support the host, other Co-chairs and JST during the second half of 2022 across the political, technical, organisational and communications tracks of the Summit.

- In order to finalise the programme, do you have additional suggestions to lead or contribute to parts of the programme, including plenary or spotlight sessions, regional dialogues, or hosting or organising stakeholder-specific breakfasts or other meetings?
