CYCLE

Data collection Oct. 2023 - Mar 2024

- A consultation and data collection workshop with all relevant stakeholders will take place in October 2023
- Data collection will be coordinated around the four thematic areas of the monitoring framework.

Dissemination of results and transition to action Jul 2024 - Sep 2024

- The reflection, dialogue, and action phase will be planned based on the final monitoring results.
- The synthesis report will be shared with all relevant stakeholders engaged, in the preparation for Phase 5



- · Scope of the monitoring: Fragility adapted questionnaire + Kampala **Principles Assessment**
- The monitoring exercise will be linked to the OCDD Voluntary National Report
- The 4th monitoring cycle in DRC will kick off officially on September 13, 2023, with a multi-stakeholder meeting.

Data review and submission Apr. - Jun 2024

- · Feedback on submitted data will be addressed and completeness and accuracy of data will be assured.
- Final confirmation of data will be submitted and confirmed to the JST

Reflection, Dialogue & Action

Oct. 2024 – ongoing until next Monitoring Round

- · The results of the monitoring will be discussed at the intra-governmental level and high-level commitment will be ensured.
- A high-level multi-stakeholder action dialogue will be organised.
- DRC will participate in peer learning sessions and will exchange lessons learned
- The reflection and dialogue will be transformed into tangible action plans and behavioral change will be generated to advance sustainable development
