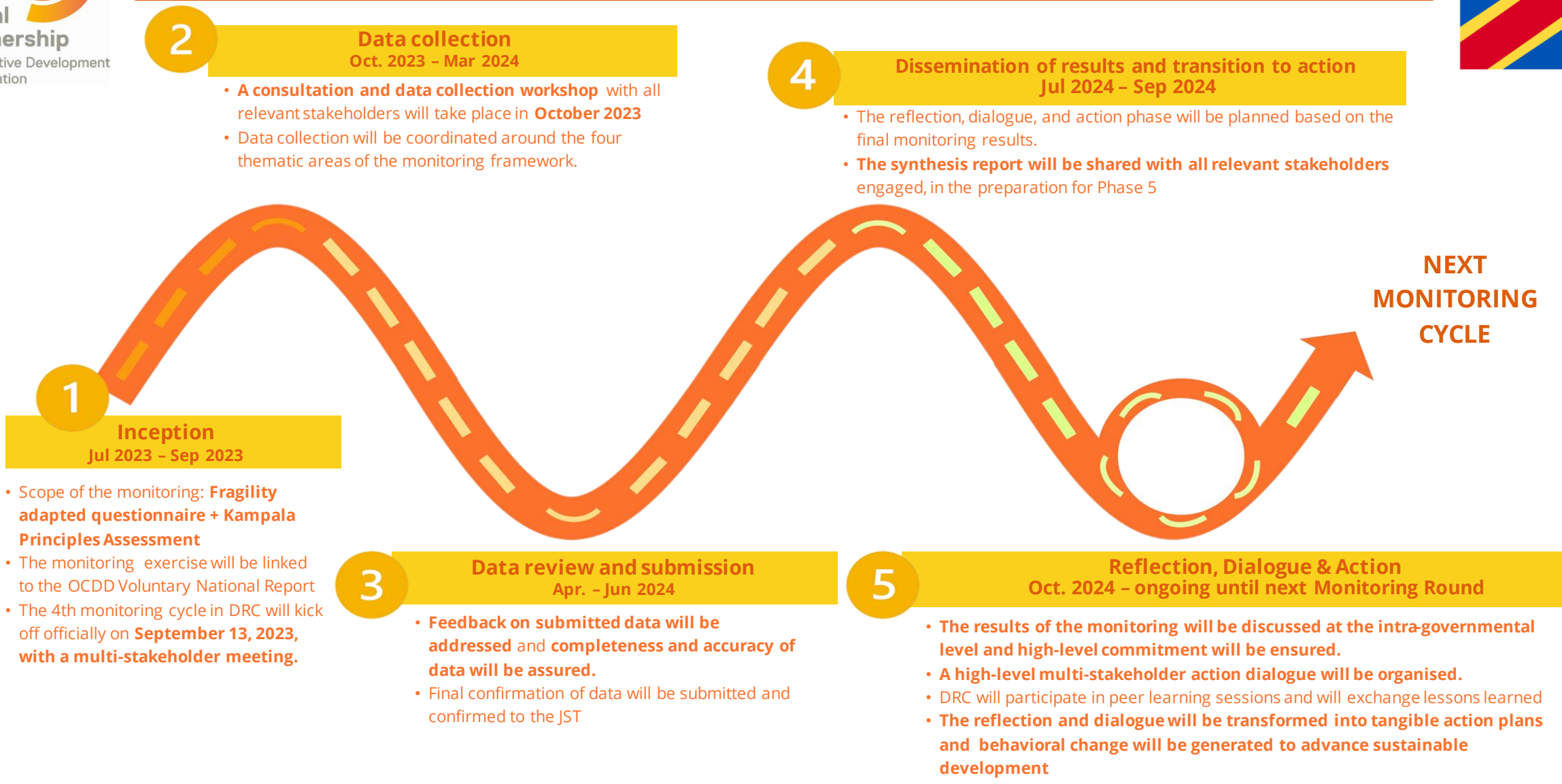




# Roadmap for the GPEDC Monitoring Exercise in DRC Kicking Off in 2023

## Inception Jul 2023 – Sep 2023

- Scope of the monitoring: **Fragility adapted questionnaire + Kampala Principles Assessment**
- The monitoring exercise will be linked to the OCDD Voluntary National Report
- The 4th monitoring cycle in DRC will kick off officially on **September 13, 2023, with a multi-stakeholder meeting.**

## Data collection Oct. 2023 – Mar 2024

- **A consultation and data collection workshop** with all relevant stakeholders will take place in **October 2023**
- Data collection will be coordinated around the four thematic areas of the monitoring framework.

## Dissemination of results and transition to action Jul 2024 – Sep 2024

- The reflection, dialogue, and action phase will be planned based on the final monitoring results.
- **The synthesis report will be shared with all relevant stakeholders** engaged, in the preparation for Phase 5

## Data review and submission Apr. – Jun 2024

- **Feedback on submitted data will be addressed** and **completeness and accuracy of data will be assured.**
- Final confirmation of data will be submitted and confirmed to the JST

## Reflection, Dialogue & Action Oct. 2024 – ongoing until next Monitoring Round

- **The results of the monitoring will be discussed at the intra-governmental level and high-level commitment will be ensured.**
- **A high-level multi-stakeholder action dialogue will be organised.**
- DRC will participate in peer learning sessions and will exchange lessons learned
- **The reflection and dialogue will be transformed into tangible action plans and behavioral change will be generated to advance sustainable development**
