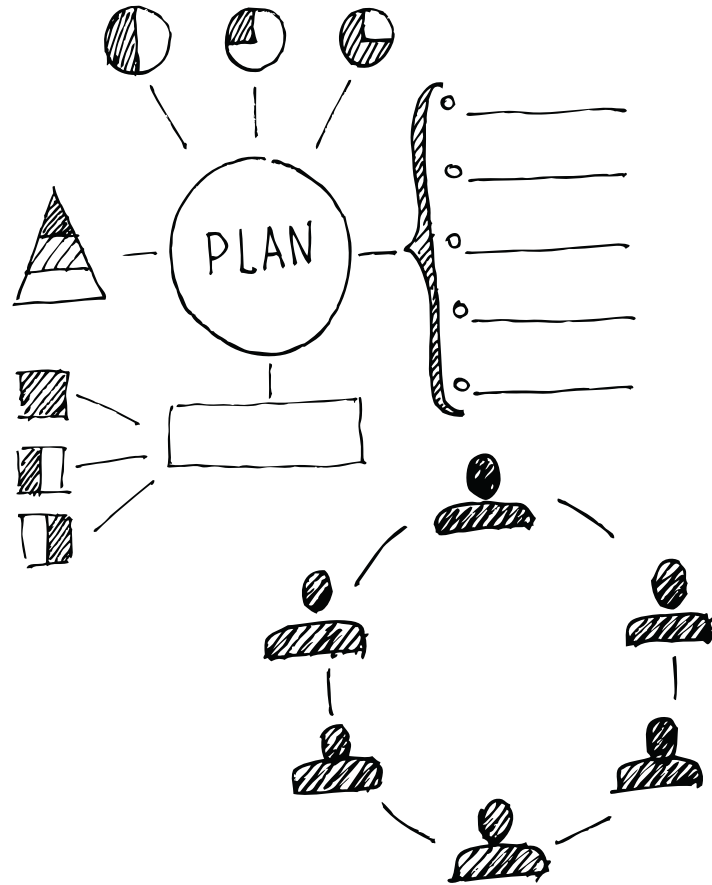

Monitoring Roadmap: Snapshot Phases 1-5

Phase 1: Inception

Duration: 1-3 months

- Decide which assessments to conduct (e.g. KPA).
- Determine if there is interest in the extra-official SSC Self-Assessment.
- Develop a monitoring roadmap.
- Identify and engage Focal points.
- Hold a multi-stakeholder kick-off meeting.

Phase 3: Data Review & Submission

Duration: min. 3 months

- Review data submitted from stakeholders; liaise accordingly
- Submit all data to JST for review; respond to JST feedback
- Submit final data.

Phase 5: Reflection, dialogue and action

Duration: ongoing till the next monitoring round

- convene a multi-stakeholder dialogue,
- collectively reflect on the results and
- translate them into tangible action plans

Pre-Inception

In 2023, 2024, or 2025 to be decided by the partner country

- Formalise commitment.
- Appoint a National Co-ordinator.
- Define the lead Ministry.
- Decide the starting year.

Phase 2: Data Collection

Duration: 1-6 months

- Coordinate across govt to report govt data
- Invite stakeholders to report their data via the online reporting tool.

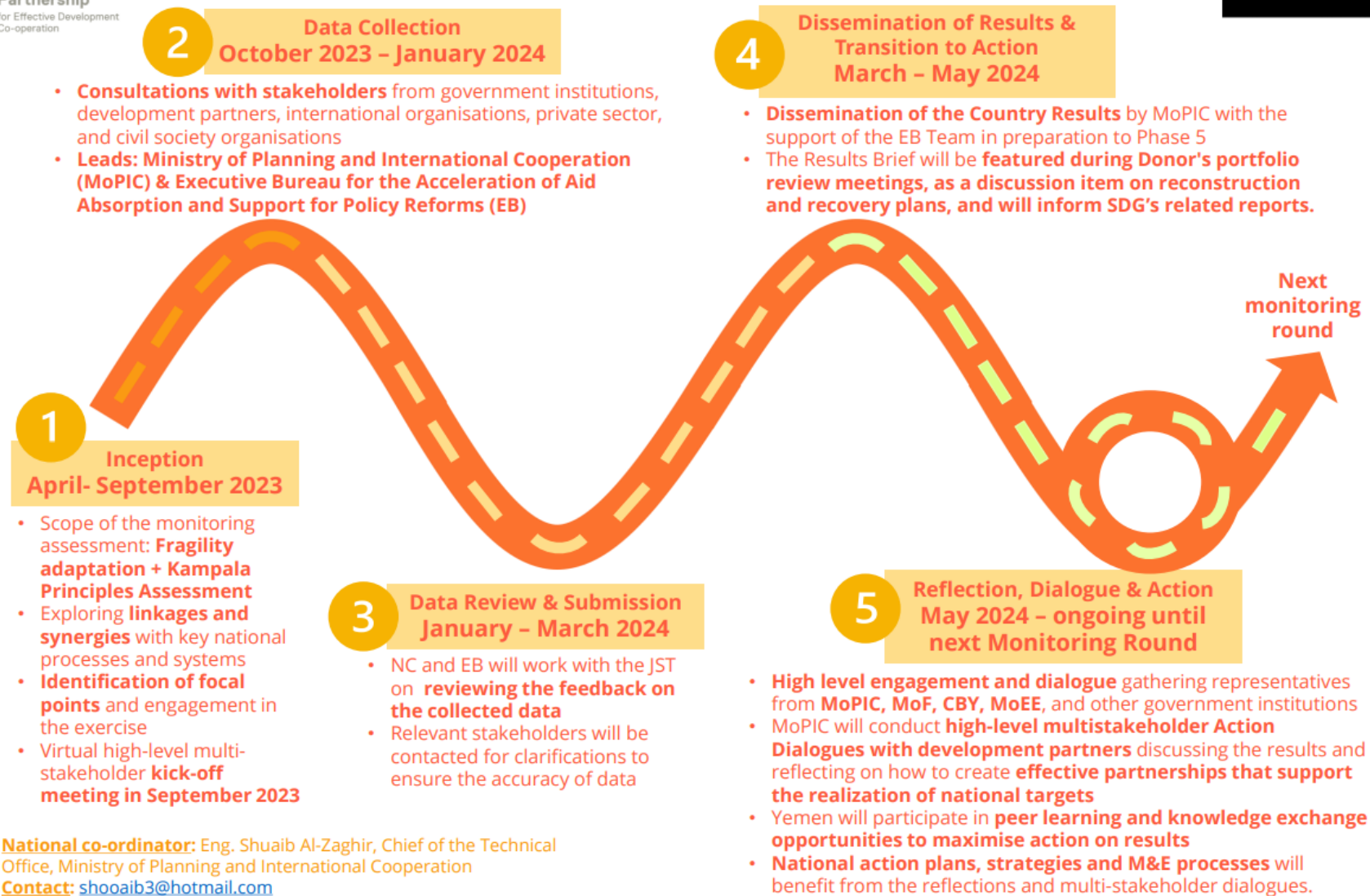
Phase 4: Dissemination of results and transition to action

Duration: min. 3 months

- Reflect on the key results and disseminate among relevant development actors in the country.
- Country results with development partners and other development actors to allow them prepare for dialogue.

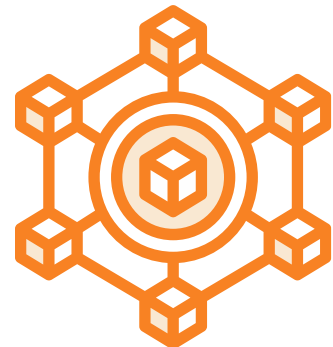
Roadmap example: Snapshot

Roadmap for the GPEDC Monitoring Exercise in Yemen Kicking Off in 2023

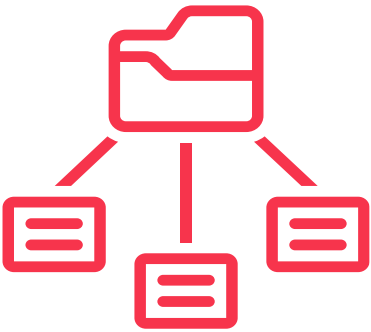


Initial findings from road maps received

Phase 1: Several countries were able to/are trying to identify synergies:



- 1. Use of existing structures:**
 - Bosnia and Herzegovina (Donor Coordination Forum),
 - Cameroon (Multi-stakeholder committee),
 - Indonesia (Multi-stakeholder forum)



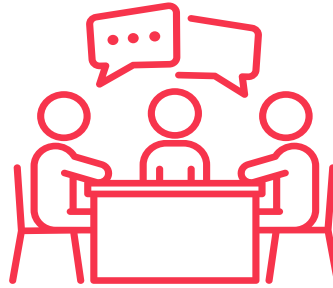
- 2. Use of collected data for other products:**
 - Benin (Development Cooperation report, Voluntary Report on SDGs),
 - DRC (Voluntary National Report of the Congolese Observatory for Sustainable Development)

Additional technical workshops to ensure data consolidation (Burkina Faso, Egypt)

- Each partner country has a country profile
 - monitoring results

 - The monitoring phase currently conducting

Monitoring Updates

News Blast:

- DRC convened its multi-stakeholder kick-off meeting and adopted their monitoring roadmap. GPEDC: 18 Sep
- Burkina Faso convened a multi-stakeholder meeting with focal points to coordinate on the progress of the data collection phase. GPEDC: 15 Sep
- 50 partner countries have confirmed their participation in the 4th Monitoring Round. GPEDC: 8 Sep
- Albania joins the 4th Monitoring Round starting in 2024. GPEDC: 8 Sep
- Honduras held a multi-stakeholder kick-off meeting with the G16+, constituted by bilateral and multilateral development partners. GPEDC: 6 Sep
- Indonesia enters the Data Collection phase. GPEDC: 5 Sep

Potential roles of UNCT

- Recommend ways to sync the exercise with other country activities, including consultations, reflection, dialogue and actions
- Help to plan action dialogues, and support facilitating joint reflection, dialogue and action
- Leverage the monitoring results and consultations for SDG implementation
- Support mobilizing development partners and other development actors

Role of the OECD-UNDP Joint Support Team of the GPEDC

- Remote technical support to the National Coordinator across all phases of the monitoring exercise
- Collates and processes the collected data
- Prepares country results brief and global reports
- Updates the GPEDC Global Dashboard
- Reports data from the monitoring exercise to SDG indicators [5.c.1](#), [17.15.1](#), and [17.16.1](#)

Potential role of a Development Partner Champion

- A DP champion can be sought to provide extra country-level support in undertaking the exercise
- Support may include co-ordination and mobilisation of other development partners, capacity building, and technical assistance
- Support may differ by country context, and more than one champion can be identified

Workshop on road map development and implementation

Instructions:

1. In a group of three discuss your roadmaps for implementation of the monitoring
2. National coordinators from the following countries will reflect on the monitoring process in country and **develop a first draft of their road map**, using their knowledge and their reflections from the previous days: **Colombia, Honduras, Peru**
3. National coordinators from the following countries will be asked to **further refine phases 4 and 5 of their road maps**, based on the current status of their country processes and the vision for Phase 5 built with the rest of the group: **Burkina Faso, Cameroun, Chad, DRC.**
4. National coordinators from the following countries will be asked to do a combination of the above: **Sierra Leone, Cote D'Ivoire, Indonesia**
5. After the small group dynamic, the moderator will lead a collective discussion about the major milestones identified by each country in their roadmap.
