



About the 2023 Busan Forum:

Delivering Better Together for Sustainable Development

Less than one year on from the Geneva Summit, which re-launched the effectiveness monitoring exercise at country level, 52 countries (and counting) have already committed to the latest round.

New data will soon be available providing insights from the country level on **how we work and partner together** for the 2030 Agenda.

On 5 and 6 December partners are convening in Seoul around the four effectiveness principles – country ownership, a focus on results, inclusiveness, and mutual accountability to catalyze progress on the SDGs:

- By bringing diverse development actors together in a principle-led approach, fostering trust; and
- By generating data for an evidencebased approach, empowering country-level policy action
- To achieve more effective development co-operation for more sustainable development results.

The Theme

Delivering Better Together for Sustainable Development: Leveraging Effective Development Cooperation.

Ministers, senior-level development co-operation policymakers and practitioners, civil society leaders, private sector actors, foundations, multilateral organizations, local and regional government officials, parliamentarians, and academia.

- Explore issues critical to strengthening development effectiveness.
- Share ideas on the role and impact of different development actors for effective multistakeholder cooperation.
