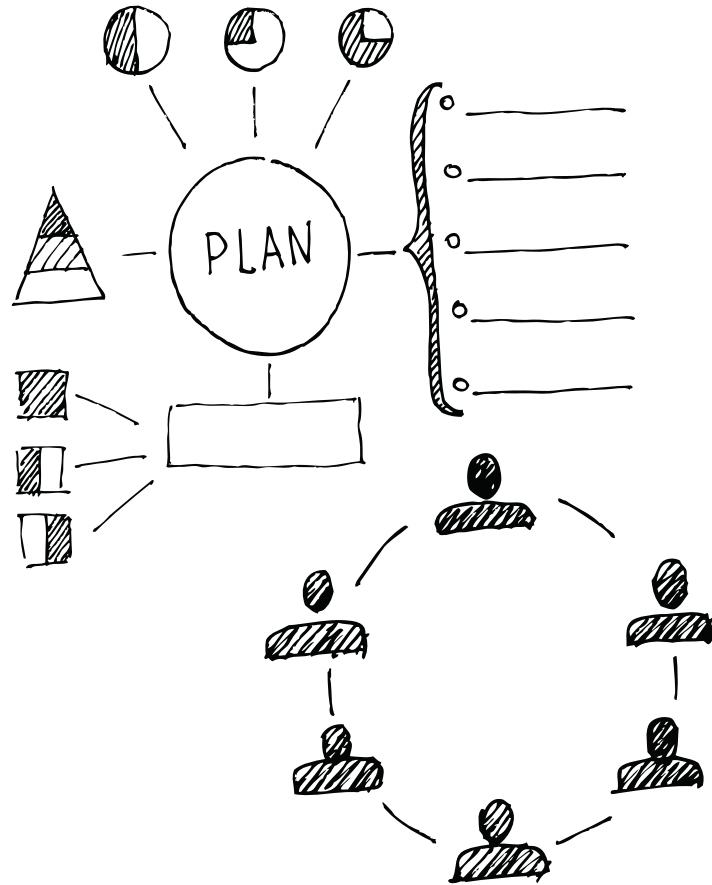

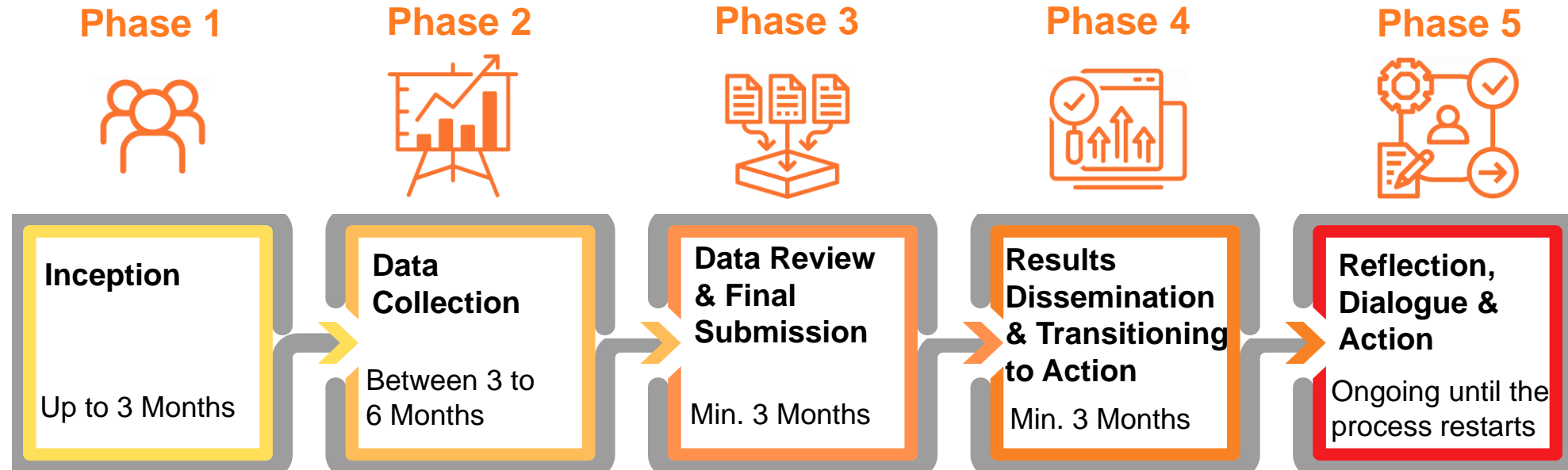

# Monitoring Roadmap: Snapshot Phase 1

## Phase 1: Inception

### Duration: 1-3 months

- Decide which assessments to conduct (e.g. KPA).
- Determine if there is interest in the extra-official SSC Self-Assessment.
- Develop a monitoring roadmap.
- Identify and engage Focal points.
- Hold a multi-stakeholder kick-off meeting.

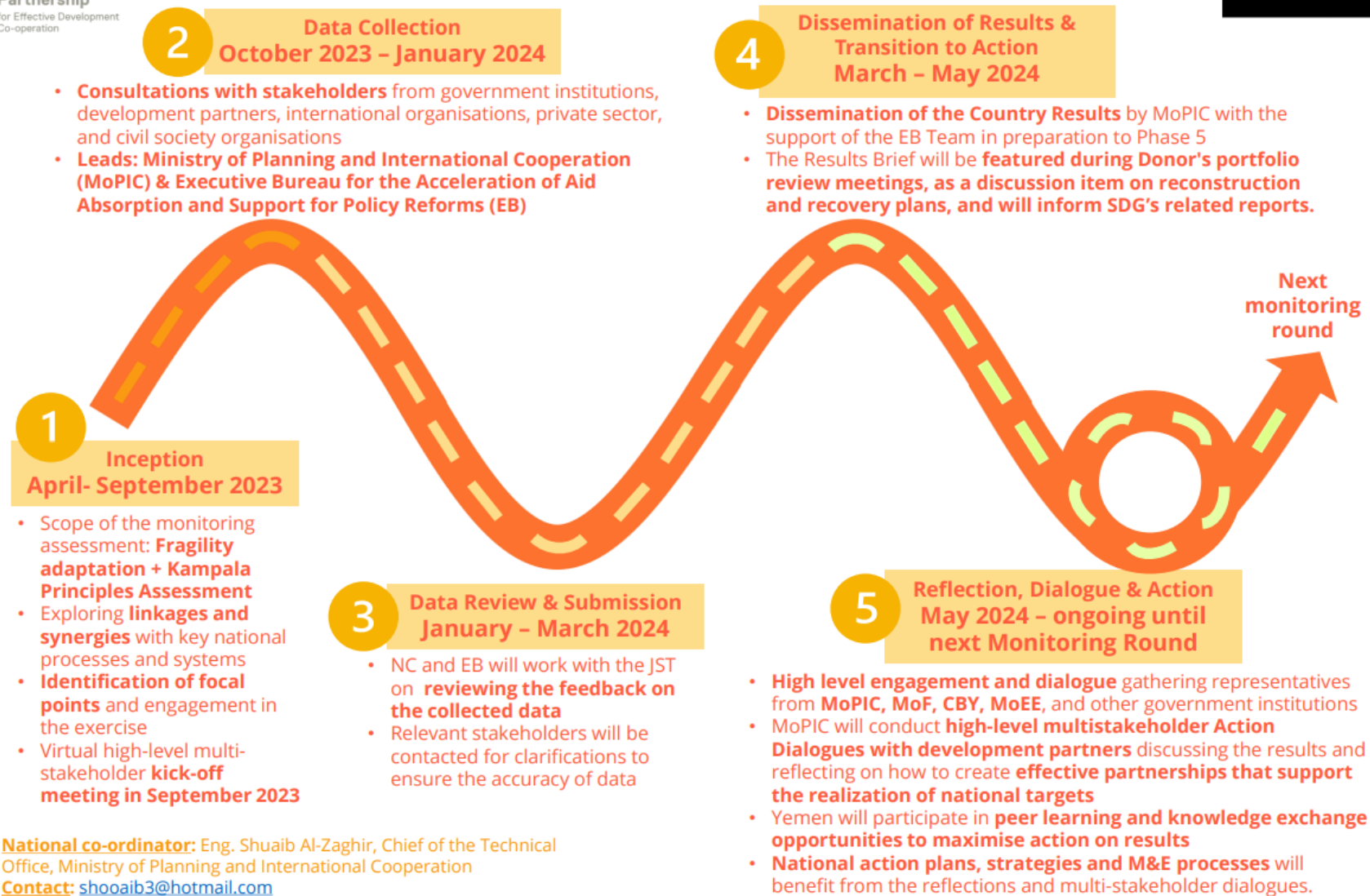

## Roadmap for the GPEDC Monitoring Exercise in Yemen Kicking Off in 2023

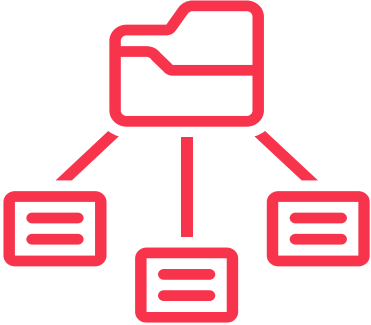


# Initial findings from road maps received

**Phase 1:** Several countries were able to/are trying to identify synergies:



- 1. Use of existing structures:**
  - Bosnia and Herzegovina (Donor Coordination Forum),
  - Cameroon (Multi-stakeholder committee),
  - Indonesia (Multi-stakeholder forum)



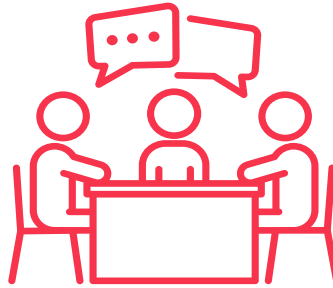
- 2. Use of collected data for other products:**
  - Benin (Development Cooperation report, Voluntary Report on SDGs),
  - DRC (Voluntary National Report of the Congolese Observatory for Sustainable Development)
