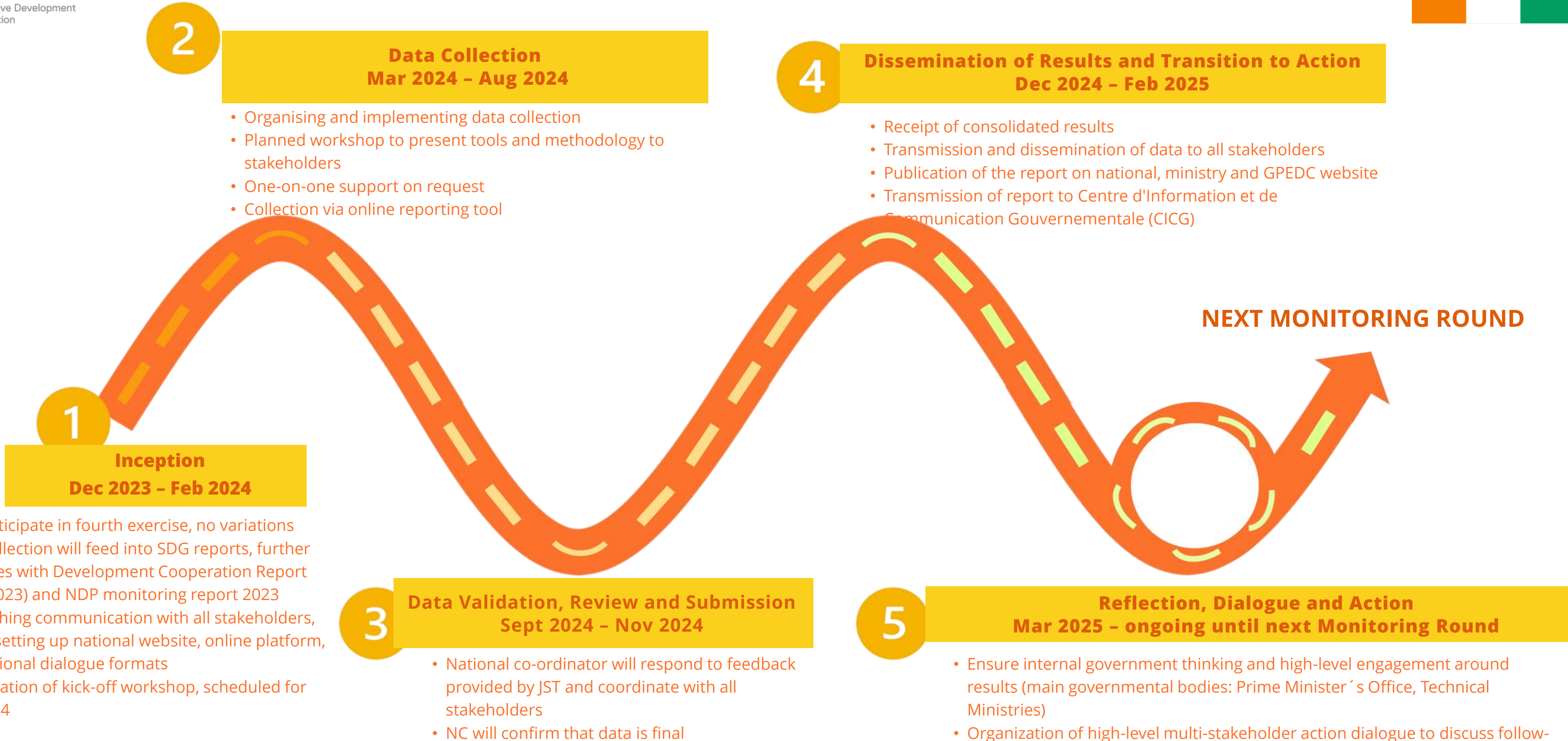
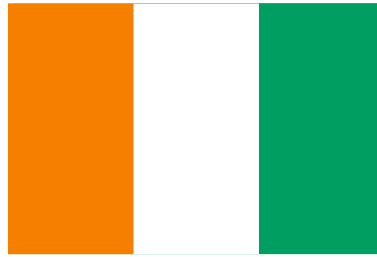


Roadmap for the GPEDC Monitoring Exercise in Côte d'Ivoire Kicking Off in 2023

Inception
Dec 2023 – Feb 2024

- Will participate in fourth exercise, no variations
- Data collection will feed into SDG reports, further synergies with Development Cooperation Report (DCR, 2023) and NDP monitoring report 2023
- Establishing communication with all stakeholders, e.g. by setting up national website, online platform, and national dialogue formats
- Organization of kick-off workshop, scheduled for Feb 2024

Data Collection
Mar 2024 – Aug 2024

- Organising and implementing data collection
- Planned workshop to present tools and methodology to stakeholders
- One-on-one support on request
- Collection via online reporting tool

Dissemination of Results and Transition to Action
Dec 2024 – Feb 2025

- Receipt of consolidated results
- Transmission and dissemination of data to all stakeholders
- Publication of the report on national, ministry and GPEDC website
- Transmission of report to Centre d'Information et de Communication Gouvernementale (CICG)

Data Validation, Review and Submission
Sept 2024 – Nov 2024

- National co-ordinator will respond to feedback provided by JST and coordinate with all stakeholders
- NC will confirm that data is final

Reflection, Dialogue and Action
Mar 2025 – ongoing until next Monitoring Round

- Ensure internal government thinking and high-level engagement around results (main governmental bodies: Prime Minister's Office, Technical Ministries)
- Organization of high-level multi-stakeholder action dialogue to discuss follow-up
- Dialogue will be part of follow-up implementation of the NDP 2021-2025
